

Lemonade Recipe

Yields: About 4-6 servings Prep time: 10 minutes





Ingredients:

- 1 cup fresh lemon juice (about 4-6 lemons)
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 4-5 cups cold water
- · Ice cubes
- · Optional garnishes: Lemon slices, fresh mint sprigs

Equipment:

- · Large pitcher or bowl
- · Measuring cups
- · Lemon squeezer (manual is best for kids)
- Stirring spoon

Instructions:

- 1. Adult Step: Prepare the Lemons. Carefully cut the lemons in half.
- 2. Squeeze the Lemons: Place a lemon half on the lemon squeezer and squeeze firmly to get all the juice into a measuring cup. Kids can help with this part! Aim for 1 cup of juice.
- 3. Make the Simple Syrup (Adult Supervision Recommended): In your pitcher or bowl, combine the 1 cup of sugar with 1 cup of hot water (adults should handle hot water). Stir well until the sugar completely dissolves. This makes a "simple syrup" which helps the sugar mix easily without gritty bits.
- Combine Ingredients: Pour the fresh lemon juice into the pitcher with the simple syrup.
- 5.Add Cold Water: Add 3-4 cups of cold water to the pitcher. Start with 3 cups, taste, and add more if you prefer it less tart.
- 6. Stir Well: Stir everything together until it's all mixed up!
- 7. Serve: Fill glasses with ice cubes and pour in your delicious homemade lemonade. Add a lemon slice or mint sprig for a fancy touch!
